We have boxes in church for people to take. Please take one and fill the box with loose change, and return them to the church in the couple of weeks after Easter.

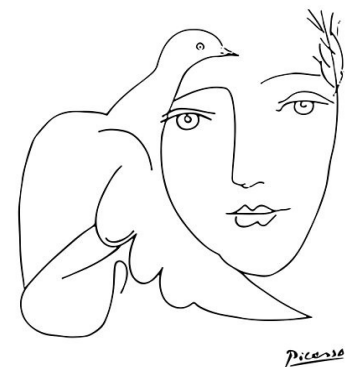
Concordia – the local Churches Together Choir run by our own Mary Boyd – is 20 years old this year!
