



** Everyone is aware that with the new Omicron Variant Covid-
19 rates are soaring. We have received new guidelines from the
Scottish Episcopal Church, which has led to these changes
agreed by the vestry.

There will be no refreshments after our services for a few weeks.

We will not be holding our Thursday Eucharist for a few weeks,
but will have online fellowship and worship instead.

The midnight Communion service is online only.

These changes have had to be introduced at very short notice,
and the vestry is monitoring the situation closely. We have not
yet sorted some of the details of the changes – please be patient
with us. Things may change quickly, and we will communicate
the best we can.
