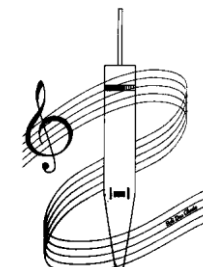
We are now making real progress in replacing the organ in church, which stopped working last year. Today we are launching our appeal to raise the money to cover the cost of the new organ – about £16,000.
