Sunday 27th March – Easter Day. We celebrate the resurrection at 9.15am or 10.30am.

Also on Easter Sunday ACTS have a morning walk of witness, starting at 8.00am at Hillhead Parish Church, ending at St. Mary's church for communion at about 8.50am.
