11.30pm: Midnight Communion

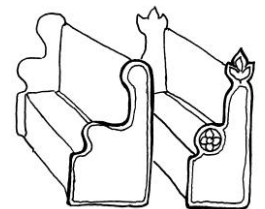
Thursday 25th December
