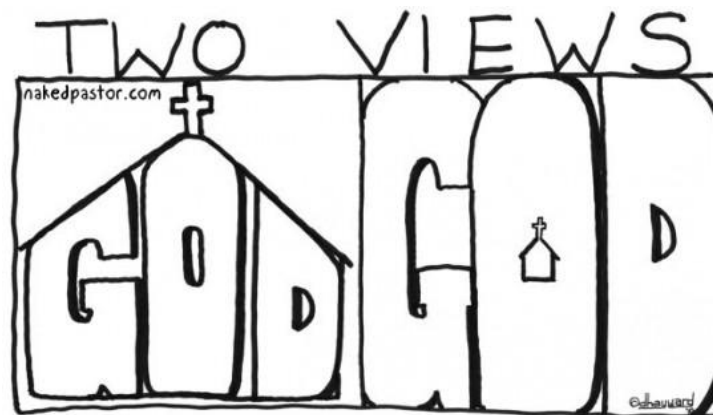
## What's Really the Story, Ballamory.....!!?!
