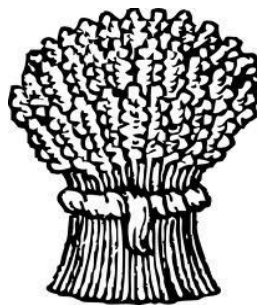
Prayer after Communion
