Many will know, but others may not, about the changes that have taken place in our church this summer. I thought it might be worth describing a bit of what has changed.

Firstly we welcome Applebays, who launched last Thursday. Applebays is a private company run by two local mothers, which provides breakfast and afterschool activities for young people mainly of primary school age. They will be renting the hall and choir vestry each morning from 7.30 – 9.00am, and from 3.00pm till tea-time. This is a major development for us – Applebays will be taking on a significant amount of time in the use of the hall. Please pray for them as they make an important contribution to community life in Lenzie, and will play a major part in the life of our church over the coming years.

The arrival of Applebays has meant some changes. We have had to increase the number of ladies toilets – and the former office has been suitably converted, with the original ladies toilets becoming the gents. We have had to clear space for storage, and some of the unnecessary stuff in our building has been disposed of – some sold, some passed on to other churches.

In the near future, it also means some changes to our grounds – we are looking to fence an area as an outdoor space for hall users, who will use the fire escape of the hall as access to this area. This will be done as much as possible within keeping of the grounds, probably using chestnut paling fencing and rustic gates.

There may be other things changing a bit in the near future – please pray for these changes, and I know everyone will help and support the changes made.
