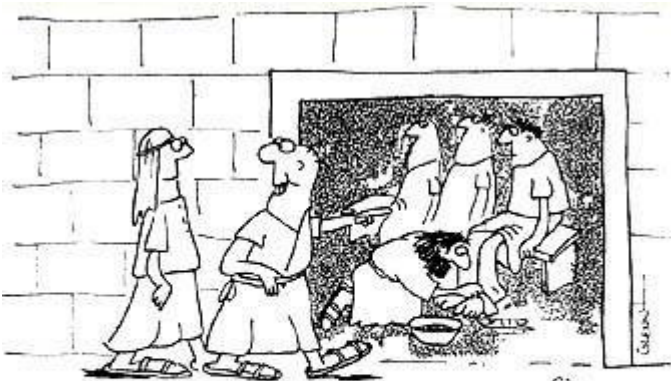
We also have Holy Communion on Thursday Morning at 10.00am, followed by Tea or Coffee: everyone welcome.
