Please note:

- ◆ All the hymns for a particular service should come from one hymn book.
- ◆ For a service you need to choose 5 hymns. The first and last hymns should be more uplifting in nature. The middle two can be what you want. The communion hymn should be thoughtful.
- ◆ The Rector reserves the right to change one or two of the hymns you may have chosen. For example, we would not want the same hymn a few weeks in a row.
- ◆ We would try to use your choices over the coming weeks, but clearly if there is a rush you may have to wait a few weeks to see your choices on the hymn board.
