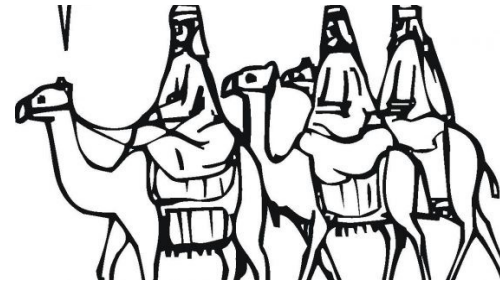

5.00pm: Christingle Service

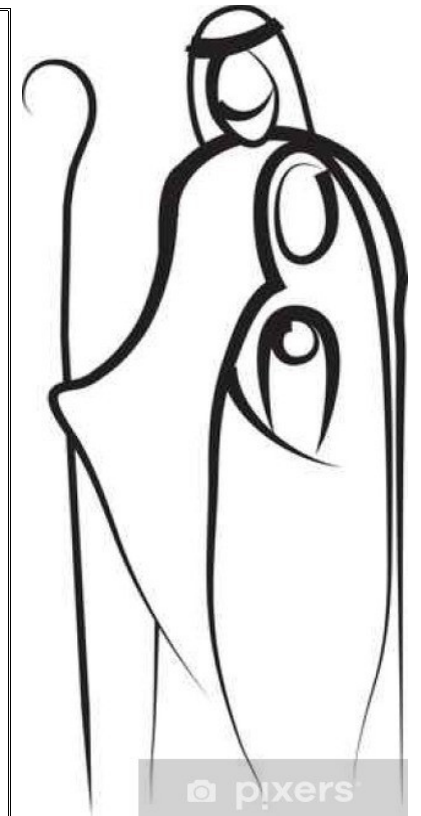
11.30pm: Midnight Communion.
