27<sup>th</sup>: An end to slavery an human trafficking across the world.

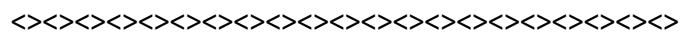
28<sup>th</sup>: Love, peace and joy within marriage.
