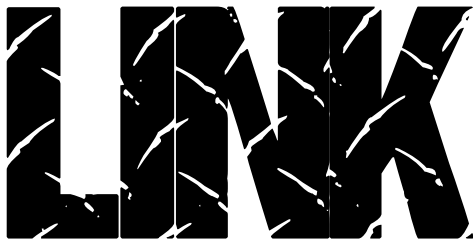


ST. CYPRIAN'S CHURCH

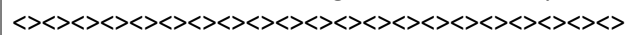
