The service at 10.30am will also be streamed on Zoom. The access codes for the zoom stream are circulated by E.mail during the week, and are also posted on our website.

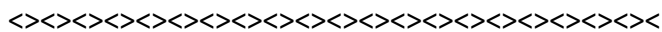
