St Cyprian's Vacancy Video

We've reached that point in the Vacancy process where the production of a video is critical to our ability to start advertising our vacancy. It's an essential component of the package of information that will help a new priest to get an impression of what we are like and whether they could work with us. We hope you will want to have your say. We propose a few different ways of doing so:

- Be part of a group discussion about an aspect of our church, which is recorded in both vision and sound
- Be recorded on video as an individual on aspect of our church that's important to you
- Be recorded in sound only to give your views as a "voice over" to accompany relevant scenes and/or photos.

Understandably, there will be a limit on the total length of the final video, so inevitably we'll have to select from the recordings what's needed to ensure we give a realistic impression of who we are. The topics we need to cover are basically what we discussed at the congregational meeting, when we considered the draft parish profile, e.g.:

- Who we are
- What we like about St Cyprian's
- Future changes we'd like to see
- What you hope a new Rector will bring and achieve with

The more different voices that we can involve, the better the view we'll be able to give. Please volunteer or at least say **yes** when asked! This is a project for all of us and our future as a congregation. Please speak to any member of the Vestry to find out more.
