When Bishop Kevin retires on 31 August 2024 it can be confirmed that, in accordance with Canon 4, the College of Bishops has the Rt. Revd. Andrew Swift as acting Bishop of Glasgow and Galloway until Bishop Kevin's successor is installed next year. He will take up this role from 1st September 2024. Bishop Andrew is currently Bishop of Brechin, a role that he will continue to hold. Bishop Andrew has worshiped with us in the past when he had a boat moored at Kirkintilloch Marina.
