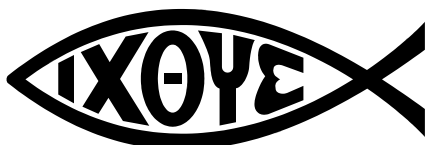

Lord Jesus, guard and grow our church as we serve you together in this period without a Rector.

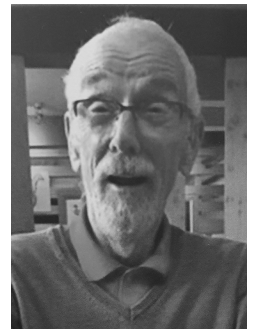
Please guide those who are seeking the right priest for us, and those who are seeking the right church for their ministry, that together we may discover your way for the future and see your kingdom grow. Amen.
