Thursday Morning Worship

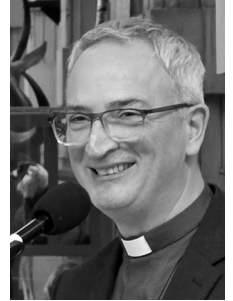
